

Driving for Mosaic during the Jewish Outdoor Escape

Due to insurance regulations, anyone driving as an “official” Mosaic driver is required to allow us to perform a check of their Motor Vehicle Records. Any asked by Mosaic to drive anyone else that is not related to that driver is required to have their MVR pulled. For simplicity, our volunteer transportation coordinator will pull the record for you. You will need to sign a permission form with pertinent data. We will then pull your MVR record via <https://checkr.com>. Mosaic will be in contact once we determine you will be a Mosaic Driver.

We will allow anyone to drive for Mosaic if you have a good driving record. You are allowed one or two minor traffic tickets, but no significant accidents where you are found at fault, or DUIs. Please do not put us in any embarrassing situations by volunteering to drive if you would not pass the MVR check.

Our Volunteer Transportation Coordinator, Terry Auspitz will be contacting you during this process. It is important you respond to invitation emails from [Checkr.com](https://checkr.com) and other emails from transportation@mosaicoutdoor.org.
